Wilderness Country Club in Naples to host community open house

Buyers looking to purchase an existing condominium in a private, gated golf course community in the heart of Naples have a chance to view over a dozen homes next weekend at Wilderness Country Club.

The country club community located on 200 forested acres along the east side of Goodlette-Frank Road just north of Golden Gate Parkway will host a Community Open House on Sunday, February 9th from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The event is an opportunity for buyers to explore the existing inventory of condominiums that are available and will include self-guided golf cart tours of the club amenities offered campus-wide.

Established in 1974, Wilderness Country Club is a groundbreaking residential development that holds the honor as the first private, gated golf course community with a mandatory membership built in Naples. The residential development, which is celebrating its 46th anniversary this year, is centrally located just minutes

from Fifth Avenue South, Waterside Shops and Gulf of Mexico beaches.

Wilderness Country Club features a total of 300 low-profile condominium residences around an 18-hole Arthur Hills designed golf course that was totally refurbished by Hills in 2003. Many of the two- and three-bedroom residences have been fully refurbished for resale while others are like a blank canvas, allowing purchasers to use their imagination and create a residence that suits their unique needs.

Individual condominiums range from approximately 1,700 square feet to more than 3,000 square feet of living space and feature an abundance of glass that brings the striking beauty of nature inside. Each residence overlooks the Wilderness Country Club golf course and comes with its own dedicated golf cart and golf cart garage. There are no trail fees and golfers can ride or walk the course any time of day.
