Rules Govern All Play

Including the Following Local Rules:

1. **EMBEDDED BALL:** Through the green a ball embedded in its own pitch-mark may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay, but no nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

EXCEPTIONS:

- a. A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if the ball is embedded in sand in an area that is not closely mown.
 - b. A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if interference by anything other than the condition covered by this Local Rule makes the stroke impracticable.
2. If a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction on or within 2 club-lengths of the putting green and within 2 club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: the ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

3. All roads within Wilderness Country Club are O.B.
